Role summary:

Students will be teaching visitors (students in preschool – grade 3) about amphibians, their relatives, and the major conservation issues affecting them, including:

- Participating in and facilitating safe handling of animal artefacts
- Setting up and cleaning up learning stations
- Leading small groups of children through stations
- Teaching small children in an age appropriate way using games and storytelling
- Handling props

Desired skills and experience:

- Outgoing, enthusiastic, and self-motivated;
- Preference to students in grades 10 – 12;
- Interest in marine biology, teaching, working with children;
- Experience and/or genuine interest in educating or interacting with students.

Special requirements:

- Students in high school, ages 14 – 18.
